

Johnson County REMC Multi-Phase Commercial Service Schedule MPC

Availability

Available in all territory served by the Corporation, in accordance with the Corporation Service Rules and Regulations.

Applicability

Applicable to commercial consumers up to and including 100 kVA.

Type of Service

Multi-phase 60 hertz at 120/208 or 277/480 volts. New service at 120/240 or 240/480 is not available. Existing 120/240 or 240/480 service as of the effective date of this rate will continue to be served.

Monthly Rate

Facility Charge: \$45.00

Purchased Power Charges: per kWh per Month

The Summer period is defined as kilowatt-hours used from June 1 to September 30.
Winter is defined as kilowatt-hours used from October 1 to May 31.

Minimum Monthly Charge

The minimum monthly charge shall be the Facility Charge.

Terms and Conditions

1. In general, motors having a rated capacity in excess of ten horsepower (10 h.p.) must be three-phase.
2. In those cases where the consumer is not located adjacent to three-phase lines of the Corporation, service will be rendered only after the following conditions are met.
 - a. The consumer will give satisfactory assurance by means of a written agreement as to the character, amount and duration of the business offered.

- b. In no case, however, will the minimum bill for three-phase service be less than that previously specified under the “Monthly Minimum Charge”.
