

# Johnson County REMC Single Phase Commercial Service Schedule SPC

## Availability

Available in all territory served by the Corporation, in accordance with the Corporation Service Rules and Regulations.

Members having their principal place of business on the same premises as their home may include service for both on the same meter, in which case all service will be billed under the schedule using the rate set out below. If the member prefers, provisions may be made for two meters, in which case usage for residential purposes will be billed under the appropriate residential schedule, and usage for business purposes will be billed under this Schedule SPC.

## Applicability

Applicable to commercial consumers up to and including 100 kVA. In general, motors having a rated capacity in excess of ten horsepower (10 h.p.) should be a three-phase service. The Corporation's Engineering department must approve any variances.

## Type of Service

Single - phase 60 hertz at 120/240 volts.

## Monthly Rate

Facility Charge: \$33.75

Purchased Power Charges: per kWh per Month

The Summer period is defined as kilowatt-hours used from June 1 to September 30.  
Winter is defined as kilowatt-hours used from October 1 to May 31.

## Minimum Monthly Charge

The minimum monthly charge shall be the Facility Charge.
