Step 3: Eligible accounts will be displayed click unenroll to unenroll from Operation Round Up

Round Up is a program offered where members can easily make a donation to those in need. When you enroll in the Round Up program, you have the option to round the amount of your bill up to the next nearest dollar. For example, if your bill is \$62.38, the amount will be rounded up to \$63.00. The 62 cents added to your bill will be placed in the Johnson County REMC Community Fund to provide financial support for charitable causes and not-for-profit organizations within the communities served by Johnson County REMC.

If your account is eligible for participation in Round Up, a button to enroll is displayed below. You will easily be able to view any contributions you make in the table below.

If you later decide you are unable to contribute, you can unenroll from the program at any time.
